



POLAR NIGHT PAINTED CANDLE

There is nothing like a beautiful candle to warm the house with glowing light. We use them during the Polar Nights of winter to light our way in the Arctic Circle. The polar night occurs in the northernmost and southernmost regions of the Earth, when the night lasts for more than 24 hours! This only happens inside the polar circle at 66 degrees north and below! Kvarøy Island is located at 66° N and 13° East!

Materials

- Any glass jar
- Translucent paper in different colors
- Decoupage glue (for example, Modge Podge)
- Battery operated tea light

Instructions

Wash the jars out in hot water and soap to remove any oily or greasy areas. Tear the translucent paper in small to medium pieces. Use a ready-made decoupage glue and apply a generous amount to the dry glass. Add one strip at a time starting from the bottom. Once on, apply glue over the strip as well and add the next strip overlapping a bit over the first strip. Continue in this manner until the whole glass is covered. Let the glass thoroughly dry and insert a battery operated tea light.
