



TOASTED COCONUT & HONEY ARCTIC SEA ICE

Did you know that Arctic sea ice keeps the polar regions cool and helps moderate global climate? Sea ice has a bright surface, so 80 percent of the sunlight that strikes it is reflected back into space. (The Arctic cold season usually begins in September and ends in March.) Try this fun dessert to make the Arctic Sea Ice yourself! The best way to get beautiful scoops of Arctic sea ice cream is to scoop it and then place the scoops on a cookie sheet. Freeze the ice cream and then just pull off the scoops when you are ready to serve them.

Ingredients

- 1 pint vanilla ice cream, slightly softened
- 2 cups shredded coconut, toasted
- 1/2 cup honey

Instructions

Place one snowball in each serving bowl. Drizzle with honey. Serve at once with a plate of your favorite cookies on the side!
